AUCTION NOTICE

It is hereby notified for the general information that the exclusive right of collection of tamarind fruits will be public auctioned on 21/10/2013 at 11:30am at this farm.

The terms and conditions are as under:

1. The Director reserves the right to accept or reject any of all bids without assigning any reason.
2. In case the highest bid is accepted on the spot, the highest bidder will have to pay 50% on the spot on the highest bid and the balance payment of 50% will have to be made within a week from the date of auction. Failing, 0.5% will be charged per day as penalty on the full amount.
3. The fruits once auctioned cannot be taken back on exchange.
4. The fruits should be collected by highest bidder without any damage to the trees at their own cost and remove with their own means. The Director shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or pilferage to the produce. The highest bidder will however be permitted to keep guard for the period specified against the item.
5. All labour and other charges for collection, transportation etc. will be borne by the successful bidder.
6. There should be no damage to the fencing or the boundary etc. in case there is any damage he has to make the loss good.
7. Any tax if leviable shall have to be paid by the successful bidder.
8. Watch and ward and collection of the fruits will be responsibility of the bidder.
9. Firewood should not be used for cooking etc. in the farm. If he and his men are found doing so the party will have to pay the penalty fixed by the Director.
10. If any Fire accident occurs due to the negligence of the party or his men, he will have to pay the damage cost fixed by the Director.
11. He will not allow or keep his family in the farm.
12. Bidder will not be allowed to remove or damage any property of the farm. Contrary to this necessary action as mentioned under the terms and conditions will be taken.
13. Other terms and conditions will be announced on the spot.
14. Sale of fruits/produce in the farm will not be allowed.
15. He will be required to intimate the name of the persons with full address required entering in the farm or required to remain in the orchard for watch and ward purpose. However, he will not be allowed to sell any of the crops to any other party.
16. The entire contract will be nullified and the money deposited for the purpose will stand forfeited in the event of violation of the above terms and conditions.
17. The party is not allowed to harvest the fruits without the prior approval of the undersigned.
18. All the bidders will have to deposit a sum of Rs.1,000-00 before the start of the bidding. The same will be refunded after the bid is over.
19. If the amount is found less than the reserved price the auctioned bid or in the quotations, any bid or all the bid/quotations can be cancelled by the director without assigning any reason and the decision of the director will be final and binding.
20. The party will have no right for anything except collection of tamarind fruits which will cease on 29/02/2014.
